It is a pleasure to serve with you on the Committee on Appropriations, and I value your leadership.

I am requesting funding in the amount of \$1,400,000 for the Village of Elmore, Ohio, in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is Village of Elmore, located at 344 Rice Street, Elmore, OH 43416.

The funding would be used to finance critical infrastructure—specifically a new a new sanitary sewer system and waterline—to serve the new Dischinger Farm residential development within Village limits and existing residences along the proposed route for sewer and water tap-ins.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds as it would ensure environmentally compliant drinking water and wastewater infrastructure is developed and installed to serve this new residential community. This new residential development addresses an existing housing deficit for the local economies within a 20-mile radius. The development also responds to growing workforce needs by creating homes for workers needed to fill jobs in the area and creating opportunities for workers skilled at building homes and installing water infrastructure.

This project has a federal nexus because it is consistent with the goals and eligible uses of the grants awarded for water and waste disposal systems in rural areas as authorized by Section 306A of the Consolidated Farm and Rural Development Act of 1972 (7 U.S.C. 1926) and as set forth in federal regulations codified at Part 1780 of Title 7 of the Code of Federal Regulations.
